The work of adding electrical lines looks very dangerous. Here you see men adding the electrical lines to be used in the Arms of Love Home for Children. The monsoon rains have been slowing the progress of building the walls, foundation and adding the electricity. Fortunately they had a good clear day to erect this pole!
